What is the AP Honors Program?

AP Honors is an academic acceleration program for advanced learners whose goals include achieving at a high academic level throughout their High School experience. The program combines a series of rigorous, nationally recognized Advanced Placement core courses with the enrichment of the Honors curriculum. Students who successfully complete AP Honors courses and excel on the AP Exam may earn college credits in a variety of subjects before they graduate high school. The AP Honors program prepares students to succeed in learning environments inside and outside the classroom.

AP Honors students master in-depth content at the college level more easily after completing AP courses in high school. Students also acquire sophisticated academic skills and increased self-confidence.

The AP Honors program is designed for students who are highly motivated and learn at an accelerated pace. Once a student enters the program, they will be enrolled in a combination of AP and Honors courses in Language Arts, Social Studies, Science and Mathematics. Advanced Placement exams are administered to students at the completion of each AP course.

After graduation, students with AP credits may opt out a number of college courses and can use this advantage to decrease the cost of college, pursue a double major, or take additional electives in their major course of study.

Program Admissions Criteria

Students must apply and be selected to participate in the AP Honors program at Atlantic Coast High School. Admission is open to all students who meet the following criteria:

1. Unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher
2. Successful completion of Algebra 1
3. Signature of parent and student on contract of understanding

Requirements to remain in the program: _

Unweighted GPA of 2.0 or higher

1. Pass all classes each year
2. Complete the required AP courses each year and take the required AP exam

District probation procedure applies.

The Application Process

- 1 Download an application from the school website at duvalschools.org/ajhs.
- 2 Turn in your complete application to the AP Honors Coordinator by the due date.
- 3 All applications will be reviewed by a selection committee of school personnel and administrators. A notification letter will be issued once the review process is complete.

Program Admission

The application deadline for Early Admission is the first Friday in February. Applications received after this date will be considered on a space-available basis only.

Completed application materials must be delivered to the main office by this date.
