Charter Schools

A charter school is a public school that operates on a contract with the Duval County School Board. Charter schools are designed to:

- *Improve student learning and academic achievement*
- *Increase learning opportunities for all students with special emphasis on low-performing students and reading*
- *Encourage the use of innovative learning methods*

Each charter school has its own transportation plan. The District does not provide transportation to charter schools.

Finding Unique Ways For Students To Reach Their Potential

School of Success Academy Charter Middle School promotes an environment in which students have the best opportunity to discover and realize their true potential. This goal is achieved through smaller class sizes and a delivery system that includes interdisciplinary approaches affording students a variety of hands-on, real-life experiences in areas such as business, community service and technology.

School of Success offers both basic and advanced education coursework as well as a special eighth-grade Career Academy which presents students with the opportunity to explore various career paths and assists them in setting short- and long-term goals for themselves.

In addition to these programs, School of Success offers the following dropout prevention programs:

- **Graduation Initiative (GI):** offers students who are sixteen or older by September 1 of the current school year, and are two or more years behind their peers, the means of returning to their proper grade placement level; feeds into the high school GI program;
- **Graduation Enhancement (GRE):** offers particularly motivated students who are at least two years behind their peers the opportunity to complete two academic years within a period of one school year.

The school also features schoolwide reading and math enrichment programs that operate under the oversight of specialists in each field.



A Family-Like Learning Community

Our greatest strength at School of Success is our small size, which allows the school staff to foster a family-like learning community in which each student is a valued member. Because all students have unique needs, they must be nurtured as individuals in order to fully realize their true possibilities.
